Animal Shelter took in 29 dogs and adopted/reclaimed 31 dogs. They also took in 82 cats and adopted out/transferred out 19 in the month of April. The Animal Shelter also took in 2 rabbits and 2 parakeets. The Animal Shelter dealt with a total of 3 bite cases, all dogs. They responded to 29 calls and impounded 11 dogs and 9 cats.
