T. Kriegl states that we need to look at the Jail Budget again as he believes it's the least efficient facility.

T. Kriegl motion to move budget to Finance with a no levy increase with the cost savings of \$532,848 to come out of the Jail operations, seconded by Dietz. Motion failed. In favor Kriegl, opposed Riek and Reppen, abstained DeGiovanni, Dietz.


