This is an official referral for entry in the Sauk County OAR Diversion Program. This program allows for diversion out of the criminal justice system along with case management support to correcting the underlying reason for your revocation/suspension.

The goal of this program is to assist offenders in obtaining a valid driver's license, reducing jail bed days if an offender is facing jail time for multiple OAR/OWL offenses, and reducing OAR/OWL offenses in Sauk County.

The first step is contacting ATTIC Correctional Services @ 608-356-4460 within three business days from today. ATTIC will then schedule an intake appointment to determine eligibility for program participation.

* If you are not eligible for this program your case will be referred back to the Sauk County District Attorney and Law Enforcement; charges may be filed.

* If you are eligible for this program your case manager will work with you to develop customized case management plan. These plans will constitute a maximum of twelve months of active case management followed up by six months of compliant time. During this compliant time you are expected to maintain your driving privileges. Upon successful completion of both requirements you will be successfully discharged from this program. You will work closely with your case manager to complete the requirements.

* If you do not comply with the rules and case plan set forth by your case manager you will be discharged from the program. Upon unsuccessful discharge charges may be filed.

* If you successfully complete the program, no charges will be filed and you will never step inside the courtroom.
