RESOLUTION NO. - 2021

ESTABLISHING THE NUMBER OF COUNTY SUPERVISORS FOR THE NEXT

Background: The Sauk County Board of Supervisors has thirty-one (31) Supervisors. In 2020, the Sauk County Board hired a County Administrator changing how the county is managed. With this change the County Board has less operational authority and is responsible for establishing policy. As such, a review has found the following:

- 1. Sauk County is the **25**th largest county in the State of Wisconsin as determined by the 2010 census with 61,976 residents.
- 2. Sauk County has the 6th largest county board (tied with two others) with thirty-one (31) members.
- 3. As of the last decennium, the state-wide average representation per county district was approximately **3,500 residents per district**. Sauk County's representation was established at 1,999 residents per district.

Estimated Representation by Proposed Board Size

The current plan calls for 31 single-member County supervisory districts. Sauk County 2010 census population — 61,976. Sauk County supervisory district target — 1,999.

Reducing the board size will impact representation as follows:
