maintains all building systems including plumbing, electrical, heating ventilation, and air	
conditioning, fire alarm, and building security in all of the county owned buildings. The	
Building Services department has seen an increase in work order requests and renovation	
project requests over the last few years. Adding a .5 FTE Maintenance Technician position	
will help with the department in keeping up on regular work order requests, and allow for	
more preventative maintenance tasks to be completed, thus saving overall maintenance	
dollars. The 2019 Building Services Budget Proposal includes funding for this position from	
tax levy.
