<u>VETERANS.</u> T. Tycznski appeared for travel request in excess of 300 miles to attend the National County Veterans Service Officer Association conference and training in Reno, Nevada. The training is scheduled for June 1 – 8, 2013. Motion by H. Netzinger, second by C. Held, to approve the travel request as presented. **Motion carried.**

<u>STRATEGIC ISSUES.</u> Discussion ensued regarding the midterm assessment process. One to two strategic issues should be generated. Committee discussed the Affordable Care Act and issues affiliated with the classification and compensation analysis. Agreed the completion of the classification and compensation analysis was of great importance at this juncture.

<u>DEPARTMENTAL UPDATE.</u> M. Posewitz distributed departmental budget numbers and activity report for the month including meetings, recruitments, terminations, labor activities, EAP utilization and benefits information.
