AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE TOWN OF WOODLAND  
COMPREHENSIVE PLAN


*Pursuant to Section 66.1001 of the Wisconsin Statutes, all units of government that enact or amend zoning, subdivision, or official mapping ordinances on or after January 1, 2010, must adopt a Comprehensive Plan. The Town of Woodland adopted a Comprehensive Plan under the authority of and procedures established by Section 66.1001 of the Wisconsin Statutes in 2008 and adopted an amendment to the plan in January of 2025. The Town of Woodland Town Board is authorized to amend the comprehensive plan. Based upon changes to the Sauk County Farmland Preservation Plan, the Plan Commission recommended changes to the to the Future Land Use Map of the Town of Woodland Comprehensive Plan, to expand the Rural Agricultural Conservation Area around the hamlet of Valton and Dutch Hollow as shown on Appendix A, which, in turn will enable an allowance for landowners within that area to participate in the Farmland Preservation Program.*

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the Town of Woodland Town Board, met in regular session, approves the revised Town of Woodland Future Land Use Map attached hereto as Appendix A.


