7. Sauk County Animal Shelter operations update:

Animal Shelter took in 50 dogs and adopted/reclaimed 55 dogs. They also took in 132 cats and adopted out 144 in the month of October.

The Animal Shelter had a total of 47 calls and picked up 14 dogs and 39 cats
The Animal Shelter dealt with a total of 8 bite cases; 2 dogs and 6 cats.
