Animal Shelter took in 41 dogs and adopted/reclaimed 33 dogs. They also took in 84 cats and adopted out/transferred out 22 in the month of December. The Animal Shelter also took 2 guinea pigs, 4 hamsters, 1 parakeet, 2 rabbits, and 1 rate.

The Animal Shelter had a total of 34 calls and picked up 11 cats and 15 dogs. The Animal Shelter dealt with a total of 3 bite cases; 3 dogs.
