7. Sauk County Animal Shelter operations update and budget presentation:  
Animal Shelter took in 49 dogs and adopted/reclaimed 48 dogs. They also took in 125 cats and adopted out/transferred out 75 in the month of September. The Animal Shelter also took in 2 rabbits. They adopted out 1 cockatiel, 1 guinea pig, and 2 gerbils. The Animal Shelter dealt with a total of 13 bite cases, 5 dogs and 6 cats and 2 bats. They responded to 55 calls and impounded 21 dogs and 26 cats and 1 rabbit.


