<u>Discussion-Wormfarm Institutes Application for a National Endowment for the Arts Grant-</u> Donna Neuwirth

Neuwirth is submitting a letter of intent for a National Endowment of Arts (NEA) Grant for the Wormfarm Institute. This letter of intent does not qualify her to apply for the grant. If approved to apply and is chosen; Neuwirth is requesting UW, Arts & Culture Committee match a portion of the \$50,000 NEA grant. Erickson will talk with county representative for potential options for the carry forward funds.
