

Grief-Support Program Features

- ♥ 12 weekly 75-minute meetings
- ♥ Fall and spring sessions available
- ♥ Small peer groups
- ♥ Trained volunteer facilitators
- ♥ Nonjudgmental, confidential setting
- ♥ Personal and confidential journals
- ♥ Weekly themes
- ♥ Games and activities
- ♥ Spanish-speaking volunteers and Spanish materials
- ♥ Childcare available for children younger than 4 years old
- ♥ **Free to all participants**

- ♥ Healing Hearts takes my dark clouds away and brings the sun. (8-year-old)
- ♥ My daughter is more open about her feelings and what she is dealing with. (Parent)
