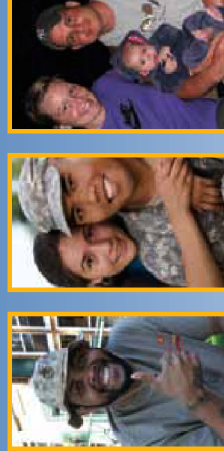
Camp American Legion is located 24 miles

South of Minocqua and Woodruff.



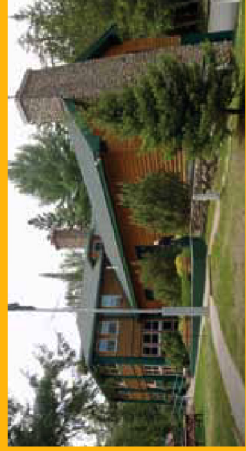
