Starting Salaries for Correctional Officers with no prior federal civilian service start at **\$26.54** per hour and up to **\$32.44** with experience.

**Currently offering a 25% Recruitment Bonus(pretax) AND Above the Minimum Rate for qualified and eligible newly hired Correctional Officer applicants.**

#### Starting Salary

Qualified GL05 Correctional Officer	\$55,380
Qualified GL06 Correctional Officer	\$59,052
Qualified GL07 Correctional Officer	\$64,121
Qualified GL08 Correctional Officer	\$67,712

EXAMPLE: GL07 Starting Salary \$64,121 with 25% bonus is approximately \$16,030-pretax (bonus on your first check)
