

VISITATION RULES

1. No use of cell phones, cameras or recording devices of any sort in the visitation room.
2. No pictures/items may be shown, without prior approval.
3. No food or drink in visitation, this includes for children also.
4. You must remain at the booth you are assigned to. Juveniles must remain with their parent(s) and at the visitation booth.
5. If you leave the visitation room, at any time during your visit, you may not go back into visitation.
6. You may only visit the inmate you are registered to see. Communicating to any other inmate will terminate the visit and may cause suspension of visiting privileges.
7. Anyone under 18, must be supervised, by an adult, at all times. This includes in the parking lot area. Juveniles may not be left in cars, in the parking lot, on the sidewalk or in the lobby, unattended by an adult.
8. Swearing and/or disrespect of staff will terminate the visit and may cause suspension of visiting privileges.
9. Visitors must be dressed in shoes, a shirt, pants, shorts or a skirt/dress (females only). Sheer or see through clothing and/or mesh shirts will not be allowed. Visitors wearing clothing too tight, too short, too low, etc., will not be allowed to visit.
No undergarments may be showing, including bra straps, no cleavage or midriff may be visible, pulling on your top is NOT sufficient, you will be asked to put on another shirt.
Arguing about your choice of dress will automatically disqualify you from visiting for the session.
10. Any indecent activity will terminate the visit and may cause suspension of visiting privileges.
11. All visitors must be sober and not under the influence of illegal drugs.
12. Anyone on a no contact list will not be allowed to visit that inmate.

**VIOLATION OF THE RULES MAY CAUSE
SUSPENSION OF VISITING PRIVILEGES**

PUBLIC VISITATION HOURS

Tuesday through Sunday 9:00 a.m. to 10:30 a.m. - You must be registered in by 10:10 a.m.

Tuesday through Thursday 7:00 p.m. to 8:30 p.m. - You must be register in by 8:10 p.m.

There is no visitation on Mondays

No evening visitation on Friday, Saturday, Sunday or Monday

Eligible Visitors

18 years or older, who have not been incarcerated in the Sauk Co. Jail/Huber within the previous 30 days.

Must have a photo ID containing full name and date of birth.

Accepted Ids are as follows:

Photo driver's license

State issued photo identification card

Military photo identification card

Resident alien photo identification card

Passports

Work photo identification card

17 years or younger must be accompanied, during the visit, by their parent or legal guardian

The parent or legal guardian must provide documentation, they are the parent or legal guardian of the child. A legible birth certificate, papers and/or proof of legal court ordered guardianship (Original birth certificate may be requested if the copy is illegible or appears to be altered)

The parent or legal guardian must provide approved proper ID.

The minor can only visit if they have not been incarcerated in the Sauk Co. Jail/Huber, within the last 30 days.

The parent or legal guardian have not been incarcerated in the Sauk Co. Jail/Huber, within the last 30 days.

The parent or legal guardian must, at all times, provide direct supervision of said minor.

NUMBER OF VISITORS

No more than 2 adults or 2 adults and 2 minors or 1 adult and 3 minors per inmate
